

Princeton Place Access to Montgomery College suggestions with expected outcomes in bold

This is a list of suggestions that have been presented to the City of Rockville from numerous sources. This list is a working document and items may be added at any instance. This list is given out for informational purposes only and does not mean that the City supports any of these suggestions. No preference is given to any suggestion and the number on the left is only for numerical purposes only. As a reminder some of these suggestions were combined or may be combined.

The outcomes are listed in bold and are indicative of what stakeholders ultimately want to happen at Princeton Place and is summarized. **For example, the suggestion to extend route 46 through College Parkway was proposed if access remained closed, by allowing access, there would be no need extend that route as it pertains to the Princeton Place Access to Montgomery College access issue.**

A. Transportation

1. Extend Route 46 through College Parkway (**allowing access**)
2. Extend Route 45 to loop through campus (**allowing access**)
3. Extend time for 45 minute runs in evening for current route through campus (**allowing access**)
4. Increase bus schedules in neighborhood (**allowing access**)
5. Place no parking signs on Princeton Place (**allowing access would necessitate some form of parking restrictions**)
6. Place permit parking signs on Princeton Place (**allowing access would necessitate some form of parking restrictions**)

B. Enforcement

1. Force students to quit smoking (**relocating gathering students away from Princeton Place**)
2. Arrest students for loitering (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
3. Expel students for creating problems at Princeton Place (**relocating gathering students away from Princeton Place**)

C. Policy

1. Designate a no smoking area around Princeton Place (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
2. Designate Anderson Park a no smoking area (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
3. Ask the Montgomery College Board of Trustees to reverse the tobacco free campus wide policy (**allowing access**)
4. Ask the Montgomery College Board of Trustees to modify the tobacco free campus wide policy to allow certain parts of the College to allow

smoking (**allowing access and relocating students away from Princeton Place**)

5. Ban smoking city-wide (**allowing access**)

D. Access Points

1. Place a gate that can automatically locked from designated times where the access point was originally located (**allowing access**)
2. Place a gate that can be manually locked at designated times where the access point was originally located (**allowing access**)
3. A gate with a card reader to control access to/from the MC campus (**allowing access**)
4. Leave the access closed so students don't gather at that location (**relocating gathering students away from Princeton Place would negate this suggestion**)
5. Leave the access the way it was (open at all times) (**allowing access**)
6. Tear down the fence encircling the campus (**allowing access**)
7. Build additional access points to the campus (**allowing access**)
8. Alternate controlled access within limited hours between Princeton Place and Scarborough access (**allowing access**)

E. Education

1. Place signs indicating that smoking kills, so that students stop smoking at Princeton Place (**relocating students away from Princeton**)
2. Conduct further studies on the impact of immediate residents and change student behavior

F. Land Use

1. Build an area on Anderson Park, accessed through the College where students can gather (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
2. Build a smoking shelter on campus (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
3. Build a smoking shelter on Anderson Park (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
4. Designate a non-enforcement smoking area on campus (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
5. Ask the City to request to the College to "lease" an easement of College (State) property to the City for purposes of a smoking area (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
6. Leave the current access closed so students don't gather at Princeton Place (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
7. Plant landscape to obstruct the view of students gathering at Princeton Place (**relocating students away from Princeton Place**)
8. Use the Scarborough access for pedestrian use (**allowing access**)
9. Build an alternate bike/pedestrian path through Anderson Park (**allowing access**)
