

**DRAFT Scenarios for Addressing Issues at Princeton Place and Montgomery College
March 20, 2009**

Information and suggestions were gathered from residents, students, Montgomery College (MC) staff and City staff. Information was collected from e-mails, testimony, in-person conversations, community meetings and telephone calls. Draft scenarios to present to the stakeholders include:

<p>Part C. MC and City of Rockville to redirect the sidewalk from Princeton Place to campus along the western edge of the campus next to Anderson Park. Provide an opening in the fence to access the campus at the rear of parking lot 9 (see attached map). Maintain a fence along both sides of the path to keep students/faculty/staff inside the campus and to maintain a barrier between the wooded park and the walking path.</p> <p>Keep the fence opening behind parking lot 9 accessible at all times.</p>	<p>Part C. MC and City of Rockville to redirect the sidewalk from Princeton Place to campus along the western edge of the campus next to Anderson Park. Provide an opening in the fence to access the campus at the rear of parking lot 9 (see attached map). Maintain a fence along both sides of the path to keep students/faculty/staff inside the campus and to maintain a barrier between the wooded park and the walking path.</p> <p>Close the opening in the fence behind parking lot 9 from Monday-Friday 9 am to 5 pm.</p>
